


**Important info

know.....**

- The elevation of Fish Lake is 8843 feet.
- The lake measures 6 miles long and 1 1/2 miles wide.
- Average water temperature of the lake ranges between 48-52 degrees with the warmest temperatures occurring in the fall.
- The lake is not bottomless. The deepest part of Fish Lake is reportedly 160 feet.
- Fish Lake basin was formed by movement and processes that formed a trough when an elongated block dropped between two faults, not by a volcano as some believe.

## Job starting dates

We start putting people to work as early as mid-April but train through early June. The seasonal operations of Fish Lake Lodge and Lakeside Resort runs from May 20th through September.

## Note to students:

*We realize that you must plan your summer job schedule around your school schedule.. With that said... For college students...the date you give*



*us as your start date is when we are expecting you for orientation and to work full time. In the fall, when school starts, we expect you to work weekends through Sept 17th.*

*Working these dates help qualify you for a year end performance bonus. For high school students, if you agree to work weekends in May, we will expect you for orientation and training on May 6th, 13th, 20th and Memorial weekend (May 26th-29th) and full time on the date you give as your starting date. In the fall we also work weekends through Sept.17th to help qualify you for the yearend performance bonus.*

## Job schedule

Everyone should expect to be scheduled to work weekends ( including Sundays) and holidays. Time off is scheduled during the week. Fish Lake Resorts operates on a six day work week. We schedule you for approximately 40 hours during those six work days and schedule your day off during the week.



An employee handbook will be distributed to you when you report for work. It will provide you with the information you will need to be successful as an employee of Fish Lake Resorts.

Housing is provided at no charge. The living accommodations are dormitory style with at least one roommate. Some restrictions and conditions apply. Employee meals are also provided at no charge in the employee service area.

You will need a valid Utah food handler permit. Arrange to get this prior to your arrival if at all possible. You will also need to complete an IRS W-4 form and other payroll forms and provide picture ID before you start work.

Details of the dress code will be provided at time of hire.

Fish Lake Resorts pays competitive wages depending upon position, experience and knowledge. Raises are available after two pay periods and are based upon seniority, aptitude, attitude and knowledge. Incentives and bonuses are available to employees who show exceptional work ethics, attitude and social skills with customers and fellow employees and complete the season.
